## Post-Award Public Hearing Notice City of Sardis 2025 Community Development Block Grant

The City of Sardis will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, November 17, 2025, at 3:00 p.m., in the Sardis City Hall Annex, 1209 Ellison Bridge Road, Sardis, GA 30456. The purpose of the hearing is to discuss the approved activities of the City of Sardis's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). On October 6, 2025, the City of Sardis was awarded CDBG 25p-x-017-2-6806 in the amount of \$867,030 to perform Phase II Sardis Water Improvements in a West Sardis Neighborhood target area composed of parts of Burke Street, Chatham Street, Farm Street, Girard Avenue, South Hill Street, Richmond Street, and Screven Street. The Phase II Sardis Water Improvements target area will benefit 91 residents, of whom 69 or 76% have low to moderate income (LMI). There are 46 households in the target area.

Items to be discussed at the Hearing include:

• The amount of funds received and a description of the activities.

• The amount of funds available for each activity and the amount of funds that will benefit low and moderate-income persons.

• The plan, if applicable, to minimize or prevent displacement of persons and the plan to assist persons who may be displaced.

• Fair Housing laws, and the City of Sardis's plan, if applicable, to further Fair Housing.

The public is invited to attend this Hearing to become informed of the project activities.
